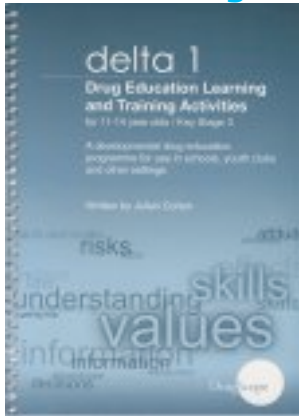

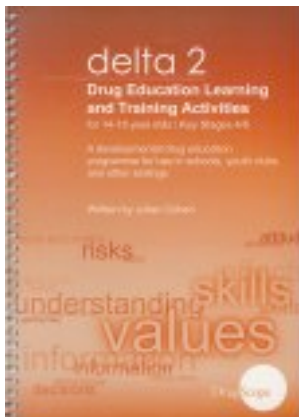

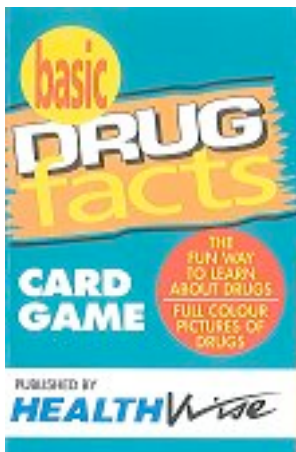

Basic Drug Facts Card Game

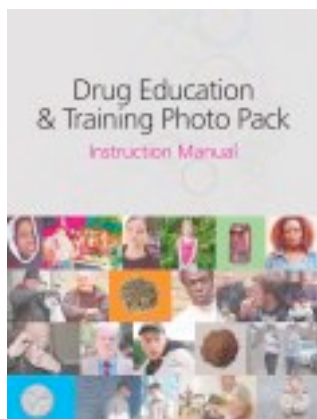

These materials are designed to provide a programme of alcohol education for use in a wide variety of settings, such as schools, Pupil Referral Units, Young Offending Teams and informal youth settings. They are aimed at young people of different educational abilities, including those with poor literacy skills, to help them to increase their knowledge of alcohol related issues, explore attitudes and values and to improve their personal and social skills.

This resource was developed by young people for young people aged between 14-19 years. It aims to raise young people's awareness and to promote sensible appropriate drinking behaviour. The photographs provide structured opportunities to explore some situations regarding the use of alcohol. Produced in conjunction with St John Ambulance, there is also some basic First Aid information for young people.
